## **SCOPE: APPOINTMENT OF AN ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT PRACTITIONER (EAP) TO CONDUCT BASIC IMPACT ASSESSMENT AND APPLICATION OF WATER USE LICENCE FOR HOMESTEAD NEWLANDS SEWER PIPE REPLACEMENT**

Johannesburg Water (JW) is an entity of the City of Johannesburg (CoJ) responsible for the provision of water and sanitation.

**The scope of a project:** The works includes upgrading of approximately 570m of existing sewer pipe from 150mm to 355mm diameter. The work will include:

- Excavation of trenches for the new pipeline.
- Laying of Heavy-Duty Class 34 sewer pipes.
- Installing new HDPE pipes where trenchless construction methods are to be employed.
- Testing of pipework and backfilling of trenches.
- Testing of backfill material for compaction.
- Reinstatement of disturbed surfaces to original condition

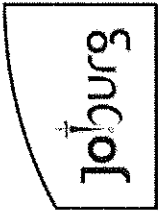
